1 Wednesday 20.03.2019	Arrival at International Airport in Tel Aviv; you will be welcomed by our tour representative who will assist you, together with your Tour Guide and driver who will be with you for the whole tour. We will proceed to the ancient City port Jaffa mention in the Old and New Testament, where the prophet Jona tried to flee from God's Call and where Peter had his vision at the House of <i>Simon the Tanner</i> . Walk in the Old City. We will proceed north to another ancient Roman City port at the Mediterranean Sea built by Herod the Great, Caesarea , with a Roman Theatre and Hippodrome. From there we will make our way to the Galilean City Nazareth, the city of Jesus boyhood. There we will visit a village from the time of Jesus, the Nazareth-Village. After that, we will see the Basilica of Annunciation , where the Angle Gabriel appeared to Mary, the mother of Christ (Luke 1) – including a walking tour at the bazaar. Leaving Nazareth, we will pass the village Cana , where Jesus made his first miracle (John 2). 2 Thursday 21.03.2019	After breakfast, we will drive to Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus Christ delivered the sermon on the mount (Matthew 5-7). We will then go to Tabgha , to the <i>Church of Multiplication</i> , where it is believed that the miracle of feeding the 5000 with two fishes and five loaves of bread happened. From there we heading to the Town of Jesus, Capernaum , one of the main cities where Jesus was healing and teaching in the Synagogue. We will see also Peter's House . We will then experience a Boat Ride on the Sea of Galilee like in the time of Jesus. Later enjoying a special lunch with the St.-Peter-Fish . We will finish our day at the Baptism Site at Yardenit , where anyone who feels to be baptized can do it. Then back to our hotel in Tiberias and overnight. 3 Friday 22.03.2019	After the breakfast and check out from the hotel, we will drive south and visit the Biblical site Beth Shean (1 Samuel 31) where the last battle of the first King of Israel, Saul, against the Philistines occur at the Base of Mt. Gilboa . Later became a Roman city. From there we will climb up to the mountains of Samaria and see a 1 to 1 replica of the Tabernacle in " Eshel HaShomron ". We will continue to the first spiritual capital of the <i>Children of Israel</i> , Shilo , from the time of Joshua till the prophet Samuel (Joshua 18). Here the original Tabernacle stood for more than 300 years, we will see the exact spot. After that we will proceed to the biblical <i>Mount of Blessing</i> , Mt. 	<p>Garazim, also known as the Holiest mountain of the Samaritans. A great viewpoint over the Biblical city of Schechem (Sichem) where Jacob bought the "Piece of Field" (Genesis 33) from the Sons of Hamor, where we will see the Tomb of Josef and "Jacob's Well", even Elon More where Abram got for the first time the Promise over this Land (Genesis 12:6-7). We will continue to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.</p>		
4 Saturday 23.03.2019	<p>After breakfast at hotel we'll drive to Jerusalem. Staring at the panorama viewpoint on the Mt. of Olives - the place where Jesus Christ spent his last week on earth, and made his way on Palm Sunday into Jerusalem, while the crowd singing "Hosanna!". We will do the same way down to the Garden of Gethsemane - the place where Jesus knelt and prayed to His Father and was betrayed by Judas. Like Jesus we will make our way from there to the House of the High Priest Caiapha, at <i>St. Peter in Gallicantu</i>, on the Mount Zion – where Peter also denied Christ three times. After this we will go the Upper Room where Jesus and his disciples had the <i>Last Supper</i>. The same room where Pentacost, the <i>Outpouring of the Holy Spirit</i>, occurred. 5 Sunday 24.03.2019	<p>After breakfast at hotel, we will go up early on the Temple Mount, where once the First Temple by Salomon and the Second temple of the time of Jesus stood. Going from there to the Pools of Bethesda, <i>Santa Anna</i>, the place where Jesus was healing the lame (John 5). Passing at the Via Dolorosa, the Way of the Cross or Way of the Suffering of Christ, through the arch of Ecce Homo, the place where Pontius Pilate sitting on the Judgment-seat and giving Jesus out to the crowd, that shouted "Crucify him!" (John 19). Walking through the Muslim, Christian and Jewish Quarter in the Old City, heading to the Western Wall (Wailing Wall), the most holiest place today for the Jews. Only remain of the Temple and the closest site the <i>Holy of Holies</i>. <p>7 Tuesday 26.03.2019</p>	<p>After breakfast at hotel, and check-out. We will pass by the oldest known city – and lowest - in the world, Jericho. After arriving to the Dead Sea we will visit Qumran- the place where 1947 the famous Dead Sea Scrolls were found by a Bedouin Shepherd. From there we heading to the heroic last stronghold of Jewish rebels against Romans, Masada - fighting for their independence 73 AD. Climbing up with a cable-car, seeing the northern palace of Herod the Great and the ramp. After this, we will enjoy time floating in the Dead Sea with his healthy minerals.
